

UTAR SCHOLARSHIPS FOR TOP ACHIEVERS (HEALTH SCIENCES PROGRAMMES)

The University provides scholarships to applicants with outstanding academic performance to pursue its undergraduate programmes other than MBBS in Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences.

Eligibility

- Malaysian citizen
- Registered student of UTAR programmes other than MBBS in Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences

Criteria for Scholarships

50% Tuition Fee Waiver

- **STPM/A-levels or equivalent:** 4A's or
- **UEC or equivalent:** 9A's or
- **Canadian Pre-University:** 95% for all subjects with a minimum of 6 subjects, or
- **South Australian Matriculation:** A's for all subjects with a minimum of 5 subjects, or
- **Kolej Tunku Abdul Rahman Diploma:** CGPA of 3.9000 and above, or
- **UTAR Foundation Programmes:** CGPA of 3.9000 and above.

25% Tuition Fee Waiver

- **Kolej Tunku Abdul Rahman Diploma:** CGPA of 3.8000 to 3.8999 or
- **UTAR Foundation Programmes:** CGPA 3.8000 to 3.8999.

Actual Results

Students with **actual results** who meet the minimum award criteria are **automatically offered** the scholarship upon submitting their Admission Application Form to the Department of Admissions and Credit Evaluation (DACE). They must then follow up by signing and returning the scholarship acceptance letter within the stipulated deadline to Division of Examinations, Awards and Scholarships (DEAS).

Forecast Results

Students who join with **forecast results** will need to submit the actual results to Department of Admission and Credit Evaluation (DACE) **within two (2) weeks** after the release of the results. Students who meet the minimum award criteria are **automatically offered** the scholarship upon submission of actual results to the Department of Admissions and Credit Evaluation (DACE).
