User Guide: Connecting to UTAR wireless network-UTARWiFi

1) Click on the wireless icon on the right hand bottom corner of your computer (shown below), Search for the available Wireless Networks



2) Select the UTARWiFi wireless network and click on the connect button



3) Once connected, start surfing using browser of your choice.



 Make sure your browser LAN/Connection Settings are set to **no proxy** Server. This is the default settings for most browsers so usually no configuration is required.
